

The last time I wrote my column I said I would write to explain the differences between the different versions in Windows Vista. I have decided not to do this now as after using my Vista I have had many problems and are continuing to have them. Initially, Vista seemed very good and very stable, but now, with the benefit of some experience I feel cannot endorse the product at this time.

The issues are many programs work differently under Vista. The main problem areas seem to be video and printer drivers but also simple processes such as installing a prepaid dial up internet connection with a cd. It has to be done manually as software vendors have not yet caught up with the new features in Vista.
